

Indoor stainless steel cylinders (mains / low-med pressure)

This diagram is provided to assist identifying parts if replacement is necessary. Contact your place of purchase or the manufacturer to enquire about parts, availability and/or service.

Element replacement

To ensure ordering the correct replacement element, check if the cylinder has a label like the one shown below. If it does order the code shown on the label.

30062: Kawai element 2 kW
(has a temp. sensor pocket)



Includes seal and backnut.

30063: Kawai element 3 kW
(has a temp. sensor pocket)



Includes seal and backnut.

Note:

- Kawai elements are fitted as standard in cylinders manufactured from June 2026 onwards.
- If you damage the Kawai element backnut and/or seal and need a replacement, these can be ordered separately:

 20936: Element backnut Kawai

 20934: Blanking plate Kawai

 20937: Element seal Kawai

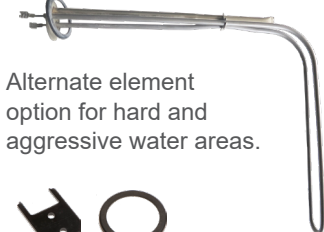
30002: 2 kW curved element



30004: 3 kW curved element



30006: 3 kW curved titanium element



Alternate element option for hard and aggressive water areas.

20356 Backnut element, to replace older or damaged nuts for 30002 / 30004



30022 Element gasket (rubber seal), to replace leaking or damaged seals for 30002 / 30004. Two seals provided in a kit.



20355 Blanking plate (incl. gasket, if the top/bottom element is not needed the blanking plate can be used to 'blank' the unused connection)



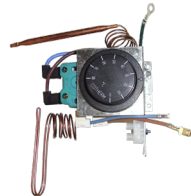
30011: Thermostat Robert Shaw yellow dial (MRT)



30015: Thermostat Robert Shaw orange dial (ART)



30016: Thermostat retrofit kit



To replace pre-2009 TSR/ TSE thermostats (no longer available) in HJ Cooper mains pressure cylinders.

30018: TPR mains pressure 850 kPa 15 mm



Replacement TPR for mains pressure cylinders.

30017: Solar probe pocket



Temperature socket probe pocket, typically ordered when installing a solar system.

30019: Element cover box



To replace old or damaged covers.

30020: Element key



To remove element backnuts

As of June 2023, the element key is no longer included with the cylinder; it is now part of the element spare kit. DO NOT leave the element key inside the element enclosure due to potential electrical hazards.
